TADA Legend Presentation to the Charles Nash Family *Only 15 awards given in 100 years*

Austin - The late Charles Nash, Chairman of the Board of Capitol Chevrolet in Austin, will be named as a "Texas Automobile Dealers Association Legend" by the Texas Automobile Dealers Association (TADA) at their 100th Anniversary Conference on April 18, 2016 at the JW Marriott Hotel in Austin.

Mr. Nash, a past Chairman of the Association, will join only 15 other dealers in the 100 year history of TADA to be recognized with the Legend Award. It is the highest honor presented to a Texas franchised dealer for service to the association, the industry, their employees and their community.

Mr. Nash was an Austin automobile dealer for 50 years and served in leadership roles throughout the community and with the association for most of that time. Nash was particularly instrumental in overseeing a building project that culminated in the construction of a nine story office tower one block from the state capital to serve as the association's headquarters.

Mr. Nash's daughter, current President of Capitol Chevrolet, Nancy Nash Harper and son Charles Durham 'Chuck' Nash, Jr., President of Chuck Nash Chevrolet in San Marcos, will accept the honor on behalf of their father at a luncheon recognizing a lifetime of community service and industry leadership.
